Dear Parents and Guardians,

To assist students to remain focused upon their academic endeavours, they are not permitted to use mobile phones, electronic music players and hand-held computer games during the school day, in after school learning situations or on school excursions or camps, unless authorised by the teacher. If students bring mobile phones or other electronic devices to school, they must be turned off and stored in their locker (Years 7 – 10) until the end of the school day.

I wish to advise that your child has breached this policy and he/she has had the following device confiscated (to be returned at the end of the day):

- Mobile Phone
- Electronic Music Player
- Hand-held Computer Game

He/She will be required to complete a lunchtime detention to reflect upon their inappropriate behaviour.

The College asks that you acknowledge the infringement by signing where indicated and have your child return this to the College Administration.

Additionally, the expectation is that the device will be held in the College Administration for the day and can be collected after school.

Should your child breach this policy on another occasion during the term, he/she may receive an after-school detention.
