Criteria

- 1. Introduction Letter:** A student-written letter that:
 - a. Identifies two Mercy Values that resonate with them personally, and why, and how they integrate these values into their daily live.
 - b. Includes examples of participation in College and community activities (e.g. volunteering, leadership, service).
 - c. Outlines the student's aspirations and how they plan to contribute to College life in Years 11 and 12.
- 2. Referees:** The names of two staff members who can act as referees (please ensure they are informed).
